Welcome to Pre-Calculus! I hope we will all have a successful school year. Pre-Calculus starts with a review of old concepts, but then takes them to a deeper level than Algebra. We will cover some topics you saw in Algebra II and will also delve into some Trigonometry. The goal of this class is to get each student ready and excited to take Calculus next year.

BE PREPARED each day with

- > YOUR COMPLETED HOMEWORK
- sharpened pencils
- ▶ lined loose-leaf paper kept in a 3-ring binder (1 ½" or 2"), designated specifically for your math notes and assignments. I'm not going to be too picky about this, but you need a place to store notes, tests, etc.
- > GRAPHING CALCULATOR

BE PROMPT. Be sure to sharpen your pencil and have your materials ready when the bell rings. Go to the restroom BEFORE class. You are expected to be in the classroom ready to work when the bell rings in order to **avoid being tardy**.

Detentions will be assigned for multiple tardies.

HOMEWORK is usually assigned every day (see http://www.baroody.org/PreCalc/HW.html for the assignments). You will be responsible for all work, including work you might miss when absent from school. You should keep your notebook organized, and all assignments done in a neat, organized manner. A list of answers will receive no homework credit- you must show work for all problems.

BE POLITE and **RESPECTFUL** of everyone in class! Everyone shares the right to learn and I expect respect not only for all the teachers at Dover-Sherborn, but also for all the students, particularly your classmates.

GRADING POLICIES

You will receive grading reports regularly. Each grading period your grade will be calculated as follows:

- Assessments are 84%
- SAT Packets are 8%
- Homework/ICE packets are 8%

This may be adjusted as the year goes on...this is currently for Term 1 only.

EXTRA HELP

We will be using a textbook, but there will also be many notes given in class, as well as assignments through worksheets. Please be organized and do not lose your notes, as the midyear and final exams are cumulative!
